

The Lutheran Episcopal Campus Ministry at UC Davis, operating out of "The Belfry," is served by Pastor Jocelynn Hughes and Pastor Casey Kloehn. Here, they operate two young adult ministries: the campus ministry to UC Davis, and LEVN: the Lutheran Episcopal Volunteer Network, a year long service corps. These ministries give college students and recent college graduates the opportunity to grow in their faith, serve, and connect with one another for fellowship and support. The ministry is an active participant in interfaith events on campus and in the community, in order to seek unity and understanding with diverse peoples. They have a busy weekly schedule, as they offer two Eucharist services each week, bible study, spirituality groups, and monthly 'Faith and Film' nights. All are welcome!

The Lutheran Campus Ministry at California State University Monterey Bay works closely with the Episcopal Campus Ministry to provide a welcoming and inclusive environment for students. The campus ministry is unique for a state university in that the ministers, Pastor Clark Brown and Father Jon Perez (Episcopal), are recognized as official campus chaplains. That allows them access to campus office space and to work closely with the campus health center. They work with students, faculty, and staff from diverse backgrounds and faith, providing opportunities for faith formation, spiritual support, worship, and occasions to serve in the wider community.

Lutheran Campus Ministry of Fresno is served by Pastor Paul Clark, and has a home just across the street from the campus of Fresno State. In addition to providing a weekly space for students to grow in faith and a monthly worship experience called Dinner Church, it is home to the synod resource center, a small group of Quakers, and a student run food pantry. The pantry is not only a source of food for the hungry, but a facilitator in student learning as groups from various classes complete service learning projects involving the pantry. We also delve into the university in a number of creative ways, seeking to engage students and share our voice in contexts outside of Bible study and worship.

Pastor Greg Schaefer of University Lutheran Church in Palo Alto writes: *"University Lutheran is celebrating its 50th anniversary, but we're calling it the "half-way mark of our first 100 years." In that way, we invite ourselves and each other to consider where God might be calling us right now and into the future. At UniLu, an intergenerational community brings together people who are disciples, seekers, devotees, skeptics, questioners, explorers, sinners, saints, scientists, poets, artists, students, neighbors, wanderers, wonderers, gay, straight, secure, insecure, speakers, listeners, young, old, confident, confirmed, curious, concerned, hopeful, hopeless, open, opening; children of God."*

Pr. Jeff Johnson serves University Lutheran Chapel of Berkeley and is the campus pastor at the University of California. The Chapel is a community of faith at work in the world. Faculty, staff, students from CAL, the GTU, and PLTS join others in our vibrant, energizing worshipping community. We provide a progressive, liturgical, welcoming, and responsive style of Christian community and prayer. Our young adult community includes many who are preparing for the ministry or committed to a year of service and simple living through the Lutheran Volunteer Corps which has a house in the Bay Area. We share our facility with the Lutheran Volunteer Corps Bay Area Office, the national office for SHARE El Salvador, and the United Nation Association East Bay Chapter.

ELCA campus ministry is a Lutheran ministry for students, faculty, staff and others on campus, not just a ministry for Lutherans. It provides an ELCA presence at more than 180 state and private colleges and universities with cooperating congregations in campus ministry at an additional 400 campuses nationwide.

Through worship, study, fellowship and service, members of the academic community taste the fullness of God's grace. As expansive as Christ's love, campus ministry reaches out to all who teach and learn, inviting them to experience the challenge of following Jesus.
