



Four Basic Principles for ELCA Leaders...

We are Church... The ELCA is a church centered around worship of the Triune God (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit) which proclaims the good news of Jesus Christ through Word and Sacrament and through Word and Service.

We are Lutheran... Lutherans proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ through a focus on God's grace received through faith along with discipleship that is a lived response to grace.

We are Church together... The ELCA recognizes the interdependence of all expressions of the church – congregations, synods, and the churchwide organization, seminaries, social ministry agencies, campus ministries, church camps and conference centers, and other affiliated agencies. This church also values the ecumenical interdependence we share with our full communion partners both locally and globally.

We are Church for the sake of the world... As baptized people of God, we believe we are freed in Christ to love and serve our neighbor. A rostered leader participates in partnerships for justice and peace locally and globally.

Candidacy is a Process...

The Candidacy Committee makes the final determination, using churchwide standards, regarding a Candidate's readiness for rostered ministry in the ELCA. It makes individual decisions at three different times during the Candidacy process: *Entrance, Endorsement and Approval*. Those who are affirmed at all three stages are then ready to serve as a **Minister of Word and Sacrament** as a Pastor or **Minister of Word and Service** as a Deacon.

Candidacy in Four Parts...

1 - Pre-Entrance – Contact Synod staff assigned to Candidacy before entry to Seminary, complete Application to Candidacy in the ELCA, the Entrance Essay and participate in an Initial Interview. Further discernment can be done with a trained Candidacy discernment mentor.

2 - Entrance – Submit application fee, complete background check, psychological evaluation, other needed documents and meet for an Entrance Interview with the Candidacy Committee prior to Seminary.

Following the Approved Entrance – Meet the Coordinator for Missional Leadership for Region 2, the Synod's Candidacy contact and the Seminary's contact for completion of the Candidate Accompaniment Plan. This plan is a written commitment of the Candidacy and Seminary process with clarification for the Candidate and all partners.

3 - Endorsement – Complete year one of Seminary, Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) or Field Experience, submit Endorsement Essay, official transcripts, and meet for Endorsement Interview.

4 - Approval – Complete and submit internship documents, official transcripts, Candidacy forms, Approval Essay and meet for Approval Interview. Provide a sermon script and YouTube link to that sermon (for some Synods).

Assignment Process – Following Approval, complete and submit Assignment documents for February (*deadline December 1*) or September (*deadline July 15*).
